## 13.0 – Kyorugi Team Qualification

### 1. OVERVIEW

- 1.1. The Taekwondo Nova Scotia (TKDNS) wishes to ensure that Nova Scotia athletes representing the TKDNS at The Canadian National Championship Competition are not engaging in a level of competition that is beyond their ability. That they are prepared, experienced, and safe while performing at an elite level of completion.

### 2. PURPOSE:

- 2.1. The TKDNS is committed to promoting professional Taekwondo instruction and support to all member athletes
- 2.2. This policy document outlines requirements for qualification to the represent Taekwondo Nova Scotia, TKDNS Team Nova Scotia at the Canadian National Taekwondo Championship Competition

### 3. SCOPE

- 3.1. Any athlete wishing to compete in the Cadet, Junior or Senior Sparring divisions at the Canadian National Taekwondo Championship Competition will follow this Policy Document.
- 3.2. First Year cadet athletes will be excluded from this policy should the Canadian Taekwondo National Championship Competition fall before the opportunity for 1<sup>st</sup> year cadets to compete in the cadet division in the required amount of time.

### 4. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1. All athletes wishing to qualify will be required to compete in at least three (3) TKDNS approved taekwondo tournaments, from the conclusion of the previous Canadian National Championship Competition annually.
- 4.2. Athletes shall compete in the highest caliber division (no recreational divisions)
- 4.3. Athletes who do not have a match but are ready to compete will be considered to have competed at the event.

### 5. Ranking Points

- 5.1. Athlete Points will be available online for all athletes.
- 5.2. Points will be awarded and posted for all approved events.
- 5.3. All outside Nova Scotia events must be submitted to the TKDNS for ranking points.
- 5.4. Athletes who have no match but still wish to collect points are not eligible for a refund.
- 5.5. Should two (2) athletes from the same school decide not to compete, no points will be given.
- 5.6. Athletes collecting points will have 30 days following publication of points to contact TKDNS in case of an error or omission.

### 6. Dispute resolution and Appeals

- 6.1. Disputes and appeals will be handled in line with our Appeals policy.
